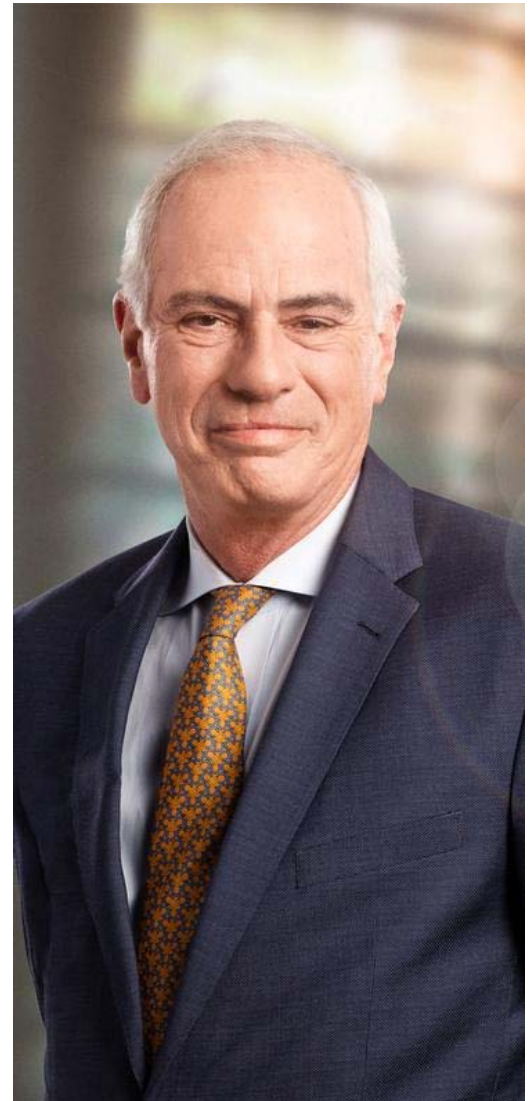
He has an in-depth understanding of the normative framework of health care services, whether they involve regulatory, contractual, or commercial issues.

In 2011, he was named professor emeritus in recognition of his many contributions to the university.

Co-author of the primary reference work on Québec health law, Mr. Molinari has also published many annotated and commented versions of the *Act respecting Health Services and Social Services* and has published nearly eighty books and articles in the fields of health care and fundamental rights.

Founding president of the *Société de médecine et de droit du Québec*, Mr. Molinari chaired the board of the *Centre hospitalier de l'Université de Montréal* from 2004 to 2012. He is also a member of many Québec,
