Nathalie Roy is the Project Manager, Training and Skills Development.

In 1992, she took the initiative of developing and leading a number of legal education activities for teenagers. Afterwards, she held a series of positions, as a journalist at the *Journal du Barreau* and the former *Presse juridique*, as an ad hoc assistant Syndic within her professional order, and as director of the legal department at CPAVIH, and she is also involved in the work of a joint committee of the bars of Quebec City and Montreal and the judiciary dealing with delays in the courts.

From 1997 to 2000, she held the position of Assistant in the Office of the Bâtonnier du Québec, where she
